


Case study

Battersea Power Station Development £9 billion pound project (to 2025) – a long term partnership across one of London's most prestigious regeneration schemes located in the heart of the Nine Elms redevelopment.

Our co-located training infrastructure supported all 8 phases of the project and in partnership with Local Authorities provided the workforce a with direct on-site access to a CSCS testing facility and classrooms for undertaking basic skills elements in Maths & English (entry 1 to level 2)

Our multilingual practitioners were supportive and ensured that learners with English as their second language were provided ESOL support.


This method maximises productivity for employers as there is less reliance on travelling with our practitioners offering support as and when it is required through remote learning channels.

We have launched over 33 online courses that are tailored to specific sector industries, with courses recognising the challenges that all individuals currently face.

Licence to practice qualifications

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We continue to support over 50% of learners enrolled to our Traineeships programmes to progress to work successfully.

We utilise our own resources to fund employer-led vocational qualifications and licence to practice qualifications (for example CSCS, L1 Health & Safety, SIA) that learners require to improve the likelihood of progressing to employment across Construction, Security, and other industry sectors.
